Dear Guardians/Parents,

Spring is here, and we are already planning for SUMMER and Summer School Adventure! Plans for an exciting summer school program have already begun. The New Haven School District will be offering an educational program highlighted with activities students are sure to enjoy. This is an adventure your children do not want to miss. Summer School Adventure is a full-day (7:50 a.m. - 2:50 p.m.) program beginning May 23 and ending June 23



for students entering Kindergarten through eighth grade. Transportation will be provided for students living in the New Haven School District; however, routes may vary from the regular school year. Breakfast (\$1.75) and lunch (\$2.45 K-6 & \$2.55 Gr7&8) will be offered at regular school prices. (If you qualify for free/reduced meals during the school year, you qualify during summer school. Any non-resident student would need to complete a form & submit to New Haven. If you did not complete a form for the 2022-23 school year, please request a form from any school office & return to NHES to determine eligibility for free/reduced prices during the summer school session.)

Summer School Adventure is a great way to keep your children active - mentally and physically. Our teaching staff prepares fun, "hands-on" lessons in math, reading, language arts, science, and social studies. Core academic classes will be taught in the morning and activity classes will be in the afternoon.

Many field trips will be offered during Summer School Adventure. We are working on scheduling trips, spirit days, interesting visitors, and more. If your child registers for New Haven volleyball or basketball camps, transportation will be provided so they can participate.

If you still need another reason to sign up for Summer School Adventure, here is it! Students may earn rewards for their overall summer school attendance/behavior. Students can receive up to \$50 simply by being at school every day and demonstrating respectful behavior.

An enrollment form is attached to this letter, and additional forms are available at New Haven Elementary School, New Haven Middle School and Franklin County R-II. In order to plan accordingly and serve our students in the best possible way, we need your forms. Please return your form to the school office by Thursday, April 28. Enrollment forms received after April 28 may not accepted. Details regarding the summer school session will follow once your child is enrolled.
